Helpful Tips for Accurate Documentation:

- Be specific and factual.
- Include location (e.g., home, parking lot, store).
- Describe what the recipient appeared not to understand.
- Note if the behavior happens repeatedly.
- Document both daytime and nighttime incidents.
- Include near misses, even if no injury occurred.
- Avoid exaggeration or assumptions.
- Keep your log consistent and up to date.
